

VSRA STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP

Guidelines and Application Form

Description/Overview:

The Virginia State Reading Association awards four scholarships in the amount of \$500.00 each to two graduate and two undergraduate student members of VSRA.

Eligibility: The candidate must be a member of a local council and VSRA; and currently attending an accredited university or college in Virginia.

Instructions/ Requirements:

- 1) Completed application that includes membership verification by local council president
- 2) Applicant's vitae
- 3) A rationale paper (1-2 pages) explaining why you should receive this scholarship.
- 4) An essay explaining how membership in VSRA can benefit you as a professional in either the present or future.
- 5) Copy of your most recent college transcript indicating your GPA
- 6) Two letters of recommendation from faculty members, one of which must be a member of your Education Department. Each recommendation should not exceed one page.
- 7) A third letter of recommendation from someone other than a faculty member that is familiar with your ability to work with people, especially children-i.e. cooperating teacher or work supervisor
